### **Residential Pile Burning is now permitted in the Antelope Valley Fire Protection District beginning September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 6:00 A.M.**

Your 2023 permit is still valid until December 31<sup>st</sup>. If you do not have a permit, please stop by the Fire Department office @1166 Larson Lane on Tuesdays or Thursdays to pick one up

The following rules apply:

- Maximum pile size is 4 foot diameter
- 10' clearance on all sides of burn pile
- Only burn dead vegetation debris
- Adult in constant attendance with shovel and water supply
- All fires will be out by Noon
- No burning in windy conditions
- You must contact the Air Resources Board every day that you burn to ensure that it is a permissible burn day
- You must contact Mono County Dispatch every day that you burn to find out if it is a permissible burn day and report your burn location
- Both numbers are on your burn permit
- **Please be fire safe and aware of where your smoke is going**
